Dear Brothers and Sisters at Grace BFC,

At the present time, our family is doing quite well ... no major illness or complaints. Our days are becoming increasingly hectic as the end of the school year draws closer. Tabita is finishing elementary school and preparing for high school admissions tests. Please pray for her to do well. We have also been asked to participate in the school's annual "Day of School" celebration. We have decided to sing as a family and our children will play their

instruments. Please pray with us and for us as we do want to give a testimony of God's glory.

As a response to our year-info letter, friends have graciously offered to take care of our flight expenses to the United States. – Praise God! So at this point we are looking into flight schedules, van rentals and of course, visits to line up. Our preferred time for visiting would have been summer. The children are out of school and the weather is nice for travel. However, attendance during summer declines as people go on vacation and we could not justify such a big expense to just come and enjoy a summer in the US. So we have opted for the next best thing which is fall of 2010. I spoke to the principals in the school and they assured me that it will be no problem to take the children out of school for a period of up to 6 weeks. As you can see, there is a lot to work on over these next few months. Please pray that we would be able to prepare a good schedule with plenty of visits to churches, home groups and any other available opportunity to share what God is doing in our country. Also please pray that we would find a large enough van for us. At CMTS they have only 15 passenger vans, and because I am a little anxious to take such a big van on the road, I bring this item up for prayer as well.

Beginning in June and well into August, we have our summer full of children's camps. Please pray for us as we prepare to minister to these children and that we would present the Gospel to them loudly and clearly.

Thank you for all your love, prayer and support. It is because of you that we are able to work here where there are still so many people unaware of the life that is available to them through a personal relationship with Christ.
